3. PAY FOR CAMP – if not already done

The cost of the camp is \$455 per student which covers transport, food, activities, materials and accommodation for the three days. Payment is due by Friday 2 December 2022 and is to be paid through the parent portal. This will enable confirmation of attendance numbers with NSW Sport & Recreation by 09 December 2022. Please note the camp cost is non-refundable.

Students with anaphylaxis or allergies must provide the school with a **current ASCIA Action Plan** while students with asthma must provide a **current Asthma Action Plan**, completed by your doctor (GP) and submitted to the school prior to the camp. If you have submitted this plan to the school already, and there have been no changes, you do not need to provide another copy.

The camp caters for most dietary requirements such as vegetarians, vegans, Halal, Kosher and allergies. However, if your child will only eat or drink a particular soy product, it is recommended they bring their own substitute. A list of essential clothing is attached. This information is also available on the school website.

It is expected <u>ALL</u> Year 7 will attend the camp. If your child is unable to attend the camp please discuss this with **Ms Howard via email.** If you are considering not allowing your child to attend camp due to financial hardship, please contact the school so we can discuss payment options. Students will have the opportunity (during the first few weeks of Term 1 2023) to choose a friend with whom to share a cabin. Cabins sleep 10 students (of the same gender).
